If Mr. Bradey's tree is correct, then he is descended from revolutionary war patriot Joshua Pruett and his son William. Knowing that Ron is known to be connected to Solomon via DNA, wouldn't this match confirm the long suspected connection between Joshua Pruett and Solomon Pruett(group B) both of whom served in the Revolutionary War? A Ydna test would not be useful because it is Mr. Bradey's mother who is a Pruett.

Most of you know that I have long searched for the parents of Francis Marion Pruett, b. 1832 who is the g-g-gf to DNA participant, Ronald E. Pruett. Because of the naming pattern of Francis Marion Pruett's sons, (1st son William Jasper, 2nd son Joshua Franklin) I have to wonder if FMP could be a son of William, and grandson to old Joshua. The two censuses in which we have found FMP, his father shows as being born in SC. FMP himself shows in one census as having been born in GA, one shows AL. Many online trees show William dying in SC, so the question arises - Was he ever in AL or GA?
