Melissa P. Phelps sent me the following note about her family research. Melissa's family is from Wilkes County, NC. Its great to have a paper trail of a family line and the DNA test to go along with it. Melissa's dad's DNA test will take about three-four weeks.

Melissa said, "I have done all the research, myself following census records etc. I am certain of my tree to Jeremiah Pruitt (born 1821) of Wilkes County, NC.. He would be my ggg grandfather. I have as his father Joel Pruitt (b. 1786) From Wilkes County. Jeremiah moved to Tazewell, Va and then to Smyth County Va. My gg Grandfather William Franklin Pruitt (B. 1847) ended up in Pike County, Ky where he married 2 more times and had more children. William Franklin Pruitt either moved to Kentucky after the death or divorce from his 1st with Elizabeth Osborne. I have been unable to determine what happened to her. However, James LaFayette Pruitt (11-5-1877) my G Grandfather stayed in Smyth County, VA. He was the son of William Franklin's 1st marriage to Elizabeth.
