James, no one knows where they are buried. It is likely they were buried on Pea Ridge in Cumberland County KY. Many of the graves are marked with a slab of rock but no names. I was told there are about 100 graves so marked. I plan to visit there while I am in KY to see for myself. I'll take photos to post here. If you look on maps you will see the headwaters of the Kettle River where their land was. There is even a Pruitt Branch (creek). I will be taking photos of that land too. None of the backwater from the dam covered their land. After my trip when I have more time I will begin to post some of the land records, etc. that I have.
