More about the Belew and Pruitt connection. In the early 1800's, some Pruitt's and some Belew's were living in White Co. Ark. About 1829, Eschol Pruitt married Lockie L. Belew. Eschol was the daughter of John Robert Pruitt, son of Jeremiah Pruitt, son of Hezekiah Pruitt, son of Samuel Pruitt, III. This is from Richard Prewitt's book "Samuel Pruitt & Elizabeth Hawker". As late as 1892, my great grandparents, Benjamin Hawker Pruitt & his wife Ann were reportedly buried in the Belew Cemetery near Rose Bud, Ark. I cound not locate their headstones, but there was one Identified Pruitt there: Bell Pruitt, 3 year old daughter of J.T. Pruitt & S. Pruitt, dated 1879, Tom Pruett

Thomas - you had me really confused. Eschol was the SON of John Robert Pruitt and Lockie was the daughter of Raymond and Dolly Belew/Bellew. Eschol and Lockie were married about 1928 not 1828 in White Co, AR. Raymond was born c 1881 in Gibson Co, TN, the son of Levi Belew. His line indeed goes back to Renney Belue. So he was descended from the Group C Prewitts.

What fun that a Group C Prewitt/Belue married a Group F Pruitt! Here's a page on Belew Cemetery which seems to have also been called Pence Cemetery.
