Andrew c 1694 - c 1763 Bedford Co, VA

Michael c 1720 - 1798 Shelby Co, KY (although he died in Jessamine Co, KY, lived in Shelby)

Judith c 1751 - before 1818 Shelby Co, KY married Zephaniah Harris 12/19/1799

The other is not as well documented:

Henry 1654 - c 1722 Henrico Co, VA

Thomas c 1693 - c 1759 Halifax Co, VA

William 1715-25 - 1813 Spartanburg Co, SC

Elizabeth before 1755 VA - ? married Joshua Shumate

I am extremely fond of Renney Belue, son of Thomas c1693 - c 1759. I worked with Helen Burcham while she was on her search for Renney's roots.

I know why Elbert matched a Farmer! Tom Prewitt gave land to "his son John Farmer" in 1757.
