"There has long been speculation that Thomas Prewitt was born in Salisbury, Wiltshire, England in 1616, and that he was the son of John Prewitt, baptised 16 Jan. 1588 in Wiltshire, married Margaret Pickemell 24 Feb. 1616 in Wiltshire. In an attempt to confirm or deny these rumors Bob Prewitt of Colorado hired British Ancestors Family History Services (<http://www.britishancestors.com/>) to search the relevant records."

"British Ancestors replied that there are entries for JOHN Prewitt's baptism and marriage at Winterbourne Earls, Wiltshire."

"The baptismal record for Thomas "Wiett", 25 May 1616, at St. Edmunds, Salisbury, has apparently been mistakenly misread as "Prett" by others in the past. So back to square one, still NO EVIDENCE of the birth or parents of Thomas Prewitt, the Immigrant."

Since Rebecca Dabbs and Henry didn't marry until 1691, she was likely born c 1670 and was a second wife.

I've found no record of Uriah c 1699's wife. Does anyone have proof that her name was Elizabeth? There was an Elizabeth who sought alimony from a Uriah Prewitt in 1783, but this Uriah had been dead 40 years by then. Does anyone have information that shows that Uriah had a son Joseph?

And we now know from DNA testing that your Wilkes line doesn't match the Henrico/Goochland line of Henry 1654 - 1722.

Definitely a lot of information has come to the discussion since April 1st (when I made that post). It is important to point out the mistakes and this group/DNA testing has helped fix many old misconceptions.

It is doubtful that Uriah has anything to do with the Wilkes line, which has been pointed out numerous times since April. The Wilkes line stops with Joseph Sr. and there have been many different alterations and additions of the line since April as well. In order not to confuse anyone, we should discuss what information we have today.
