Here are a few tidbits from our correspondence. She has the estate record for Jacob Pruett (1760-1821). Jacob had a son names Jacob Henry that settled in Muscogee Co GA and also son Henry (I have copies of their wills).

She lists the children of Jacob Sr. as Martin m. Nancy Buice; James, JP of Jones Co GA, Solomon, Jacob Henry, Henry, Elizabeth m. William Means and unknown daughter believed to have married Seth Williamson.

Quoting from an email of 5/3/1997: I am descended through Jacob b. 1760 d. 1821 in Jones Co. G married

Jary, through John Pruett b 1785 m. Mary Williamson d 1842, through James Madison Pruett b 1815 m. Louisa Feagin, through Samuel Thomas Pruett b 1846 m. Cora Florence, through Samuel Thomas Pruett m. Ruby Worley 1913 through Otis Worley Pruett b. 1917, my father. John Pruett left JOnes Co GA around 1819-20 came to Alabama and his family stayed in the Midway, Bullock Co AL area. Then Pike then Barbour now Bullock. My father still owned original Pruett land until 1964 after my grandmother died. I have a picture of the Pruett homeplace built around 1840. It burned in the 1940's. It was a beautiful two story home with porches all around both stories. I remember going to Midway as a child to see my grandparents. It is a very very small town in AL between Union Springs and Montgomery. It was larger when my father lived there. Jacob Henry's sons, Mealing Eugene and Dr. Jacob Henry are buried in the Midway Cemetery near by

grandparents and ggrandparents. The graves are out near the Feagin farm on the road to Hurtsboro called Fellowship Cemetery, overgrown and not cared for. That is were John, his wife Mary, James Madison, Louisa and their children are buried. Regards

His father listed on his death certificate is listed as S.D. Pruitt and mother Santhy Sims. This is apparently Samuel Daniel Pruitt 1846 Georgia died 1915 Alabama. His mother is Minerva Samantha Sims. (gg grandfather) His father is Joesph B. Pruett 1821 Georgia d.1896 AL. His father is Davis Pruett b.1797 SC or GA d.1882 AL. That is where the trail ends. Im not sure.
